# **SECTION 3 — HAZARDS IDENTIFICATION**

#### **ROUTES OF EXPOSURE**

INHALATION of vapor or spray mist.

EYE or SKIN contact with the product, vapor or spray mist.

## **EFFECTS OF OVEREXPOSURE**
